This is in reference to the Inspection Report submitted under the April 16, 2009 cover letter by Greenman-Pederson, Inc. for the above referenced dam.

Based upon a review of the inspection report, the above-referenced dam was found to be in a poor condition with maintenance and repairs necessary.

The submitted inspection report identifies a need for a revised inundation map, and a permit application for the dam rehabilitation. Please revise the compliance schedule to include time frames for submittal of a permit application for rehabilitation and start of construction. Because the inundation map revisions are dependant on other studies, please provide a status report and a deadline for submission, if possible.
