Dear Mr. Moyle,

It is our understanding that on or about September 29, 2009 Rock Ridge CC made a request by letter to revise the previously submitted Compliance Schedule (dated 4/15/09) which had been contained in the 2008 Regular Inspection Report. On February 11, 2010, your office requested that the following documentation be submitted by the associated dates:

7/1/2010 Conceptual Design Report
11/21/10 Perform and Submit Regular Inspection
4/1/11 Make Permit Application(s) for rehabilitation project
9/15/10 Commence Construction

In our 2005 Report, we recommended an overtopping armor concept solution. NJDEP subsequently approved the 100 year spillway design flood of 1687 cfs which would require an overtopping armor solution.

As you are aware, Rock Ridge is consulting with counsel, who has reached out to Mr. Moyle about various matters. Given summer schedules it has been difficult to address open matters so as to make decisions. To that end, we request an extension to October 15, 2010 to either (i) provide the Conceptual Design Report as an initial deliverable to include a schedule for all other open deliverables or (ii) propose a meeting with NJDEP in Trenton to discuss alternate or final resolution(s) of the matter. This schedule will allow time for Rock Ridge to obtain a report from its counsel, make decisions, and, if approved, for us to arrange for and complete a Geotechnical investigation in support of overtopping armor sizing for the dam. Spillway modifications are not anticipated and are not recommended due to the potential for loss of storage damage downstream. We and Rock Ridge appreciate NJDEP's cooperation and understanding.
